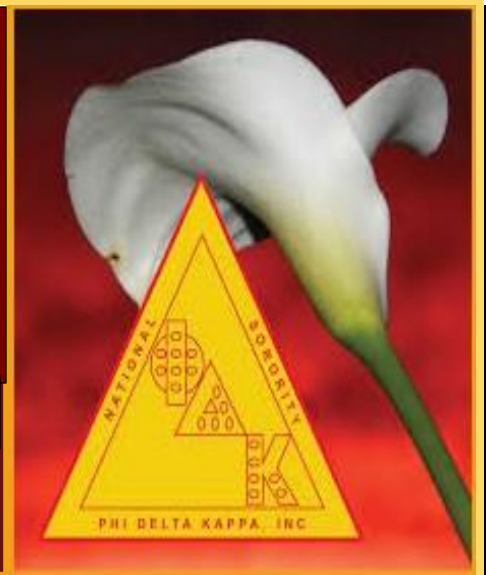

COVID PRECAUTIONS

Staying safe during Covid-19 is going to be a challenge for the foreseeable future. Here are some tips from the CDC.

- For household members who are at increased risk, pick a room in your house for separating them.
- Take extra care with elders and those with serious underlying health conditions.
- Wash your hands often.
- DO NOT touch your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Stay at least 6 feet (2 arms' length) from other people.
- Stay home when you're sick.
- Cough and sneeze into your elbow
- Sanitize frequently touched objects and surfaces
- If you have a fever, cough, loss of smell and taste and other symptoms, you might have COVID-19. Most people have a mild reaction and are able to recover at home. If you think you may have been exposed to COVID-19, contact your healthcare provider.
